A. IDENTIFICATION OF THE APPLICANT

The register of members is kept at the headquarters of the Organisation by the Secretary General. This register contains the surnames, first names, nationalities, residences, identity card or national register numbers and e-mail addresses of the members, or in the case of a legal entity, the name, legal form and address of the registered office (Art 6.1 of the Constitution of GBEF).

H. ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP FEE

The amount of the annual membership fee is set by the General Meeting, but may not exceed five per cent (5%) of the member's net annual income. Within this limit, the General Meeting decides on the amount of the membership fee and any reductions. Membership fees are compulsory for full members (Art. 8.1 of the Articles of Association). In addition to the annual subscription, each member is encouraged to contribute to the life of the Organisation with his or her spiritual, human and financial resources (Art. 8.2 of the Constitution). At the 2021 and 2022 General Assemblies, it was decided that each member should pay its annual membership fee according to its means and the conviction of the Holy Spirit.
