## Message from the Chairman

The Lord said to Gideon: ‘‘Go in the strength you have and save Israel out of Midian’s hand. Am I not sending you?’’ (Judges 6, 14). The members of the Groupe Biblique d’Évangélisation Sans Frontières (GBEF), spread throughout the world, particularly in Africa, North America and Europe, have decided to leave the comfort zones and take a step of faith, with the resources God has made available to us, to proclaim the Gospel of Jesus Christ. In doing so, our aim is to make disciples of Jesus Christ of all nations, races and tribes of the world and to teach them to observe all that the Lord Jesus commanded (Matthew 28:19-20).



GBEF was founded on 24 July 2021. Throughout 2021 and 2022, we focused our activities on the administrative procedures required to set up the international missionary organisation, taking into account the legal requirements in Belgium, where the organisation's registered office is located. These two years were also marked by the gathering and spiritual strengthening of members through prayer meetings and the sharing of the Word of God online (on zoom), as well as social actions in favour of members in need.

During 2023, we not only organised online evangelistic meetings, but also took the first step towards physical evangelistic missions on the ground.

During the year under review, we carried out evangelistic missions in various countries in Africa and North America. The first international evangelistic mission was to Eldoret in Kenya. This mission lasted 5 days and was organised in partnership with Christian Outreach Ministry Worldwide, Pioneer Faith Church. Our missionary team (11 missionaries) spent 5 days in this East African town and organised seminars for couples and young people, as well as outdoor evangelistic crusades in the same town. Evangelistic visits were also carried out by our teams working in the Rwanda and North America zones. In addition, we cannot list all the activities performed at individual level by GBEF members following the exhortations, encouragement and facilities provided by the organization. During our weekly prayer meetings and online sharing of God's word on zoom , we continue to receive testimonies from brothers and sisters on how the Holy Spirit is using them to bring souls to Christ.

We are firmly convinced that the Holy Spirit makes the seed we continually plant grow and flourish. God relentlessly pursues and seeks to save people from every tribe, language, people and nation. We pray that you will be encouraged as you read this report on the year 2023! We consider you a true partner and collaborator with GBEF in this noble mission to proclaim the Gospel of Jesus Christ to the ends of the earth and without borders. Thank you for joining us in this work to advance the Kingdom of God!

# OUR HISTORY

## SPIRITUAL AWAKENING IN UNIVERSITIES

Between 1987 and 1994, God poured an exceptional revival into the National University of Rwanda and other higher education establishments of the time. A movement known as the 'Groupe Biblique Universitaire' (GBU) operated within these educational institutions. The mission of this movement was to teach its members the word of God, to accompany them in their spiritual growth, to lead other students to become disciples of Jesus Christ, to announce the good news in secondary schools and to collaborate with churches to spread the Gospel through crusades in stadiums and other public places.



This revival echoed throughout the country when these students, supported by their Christian friends who accompanied them in this ministry, zealously committed them-

selves to spreading the Gospel throughout Rwanda.

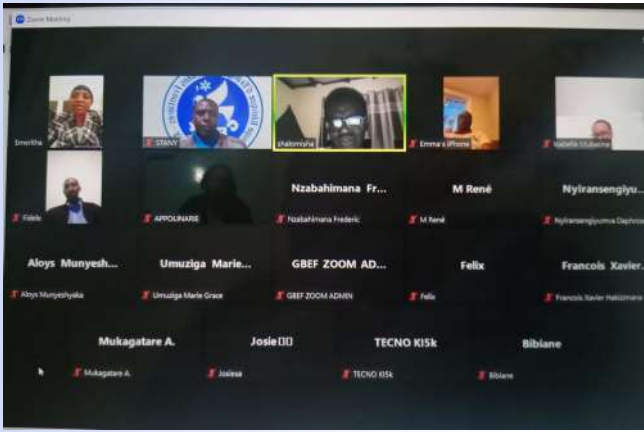
Throughout this revival, God repeatedly revealed to the members that he was going to send them to the nations of the world to proclaim the good news of salvation.

## SCATTERED ALL OVER THE WORLD

In 1994, during the genocide perpetrated against the Tutsis, some members of the GBU were killed, others were dispersed to different countries, while others remained in Rwanda. Whether those who left the country or those who stayed, they all continued God's work by bearing witness to his strength and power wherever God sent them.

## ONLINE REUNIFICATION

In September 2017, some of the brothers came up with the idea of creating a WhatsApp group to reconnect and communicate with each other, especially as social media had become commonplace. Those who were able to join the WhatsApp group celebrated their reunion and discovered the joy of reconnecting after a 23-year period of separation. Since then, membership of the group has continued to grow. In September 2020, a new initiative was launched: holding online meetings via the Zoom application.



n accordance with its main mission, vision and purpose, the organization was named 'Groupe Biblique d'Évangélisation sans Frontières (GBEF)' in French, 'Bible Fellowship for Evangelism without Borders (BFEB)' in English and 'Umuryango ugamiye Ivugabutumwa ritagira Impaka' in Kinyarwanda. There is no doubt that GBEF is not the result of human zeal, but rather the fulfilment of God's plan for the founding members.

This initiative triggered another revival. The former members of the GBU from 1987-1994 and their companions in the ministry committed themselves to meeting every day to share the Word of God, to pray, to edify themselves through the testimony of what God had done to them, to rekindle the flame of the Spirit in those who were spiritually lethargic and to continue to seek out others who were scattered all over the world to unite in prayer in order to rekindle the spiritual awakening in them.

The Organization's constituent General Assembly was held on 24 July 2021 to adopt the Constitution and appoint the members of the various statutory bodies. The General Assembly appointed five (5) members of the Board of Directors, the Secretary General responsible for the day-to-day management of the Organization and three (3) members of the Audit and Technical Advisory Committee. The GBEF is a Christian missionary organization registered in Belgium under the number BE0787367905.

## NAISSANCE DU GEBEF

With this initiative to get together using the Zoom application, the members were reminded of God's promise. They finally realized that wherever they are today, each one of them is already serving the Lord (some of them have founded churches, others are at work within the local churches of which they are members, while others are serving the Lord in different areas wherever God has placed them). Nevertheless, they felt the need to work in synergy to better fulfil the mission that the Lord had entrusted to them. So they decided to establish a Christian missionary organization.





# OUR MISSION

The mission of GBEF is to spread the Gospel and to make disciples of Jesus Christ of all nations, races and tribes of the world, and to teach them to observe all that the Lord Jesus commanded.

This mission is particularly directed towards regions not yet evangelised or where the active presence of Christian churches is not tangible.



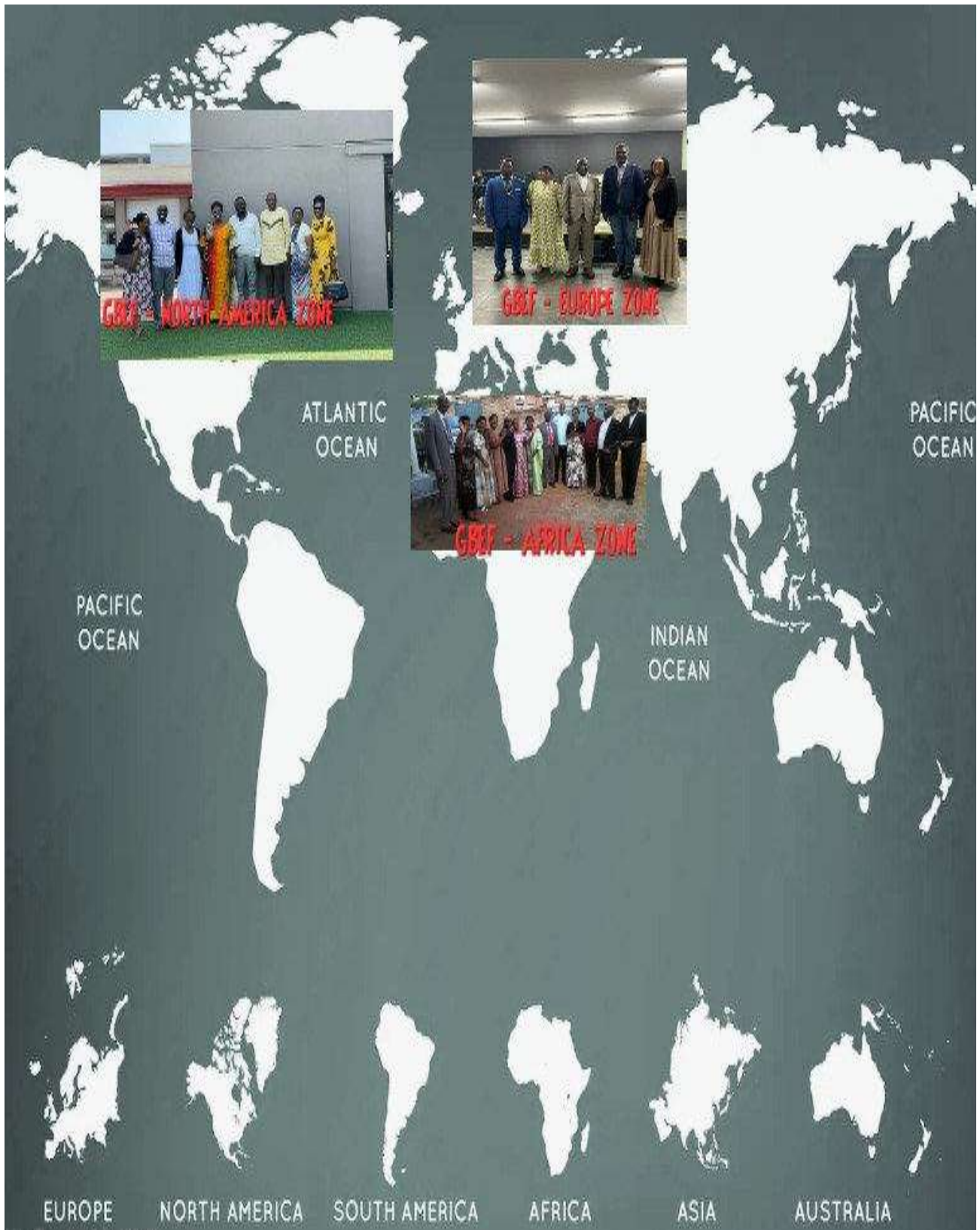
# OUR VISION

GBEF has set up a Scripture Fund. **A prayer request:** Pray that the fund will be sufficient to provide the needy with a Bible in their mother tongue.

## 2. Evangelism in Rwanda

- ◆ In February 2023, the brothers and sisters of the Africa/Rwanda zone visited and shared the Word of God at the Church of Pentecost in Rwanda, Kama-shashi Chapel, Kanombe, Kigali (Rwanda).



- ◆ After the mission, the whole team was received by our brother Fidèle at his residence in Kanombe.





## B. Mission trips to North America (USA & CANADA)

- ◆ In **May** and **July 2023**, our missionary team in North America (United States of America and Canada) visited and shared the word of God at the Buffalo Church in the United States of America.



- ◆ When the mission was over, most of the team was welcomed by Sister Patricie in Pennsylvania.



## C. Evangelism trips in Europe

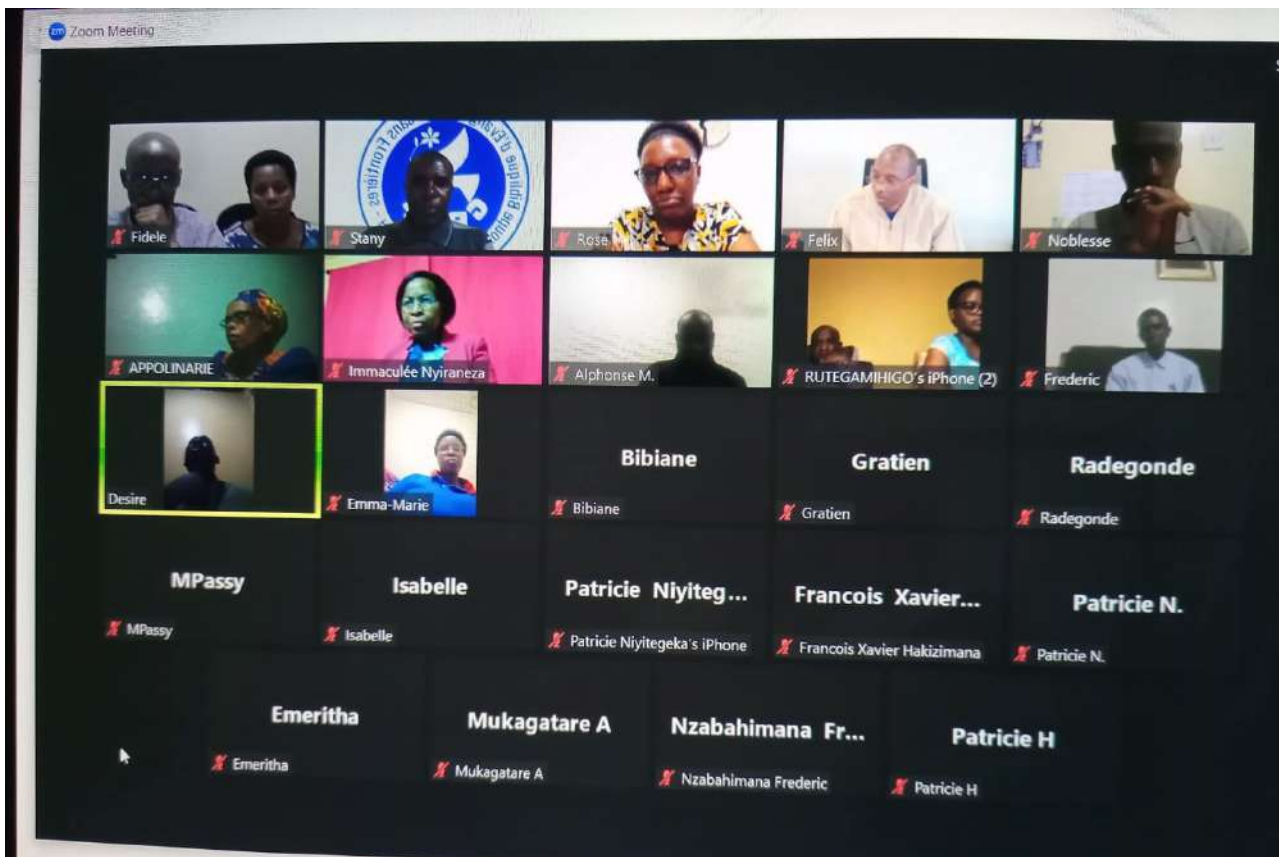

### III. ONLINE EVANGELIZATION MEETINGS

- Every Monday, we organise evangelistic meetings via a zoom application, open to anyone who understands the Kinyarwanda language (from 7.30pm to 2.30pm, Kigali time).
- Once a month, a weekend (Saturday) is consecrated to an international online evangelistic crusade.
- Twice a year, during the school holidays, we organize international conferences for young people.
- In North America, prayer meetings are organized once a month in Kinyarwanda.



## IV. GETTING YOUNG PEOPLE INVOLVED

## THE LAST CALL BULLETIN No.3

### AARON'S TESTIMONY

Aaron is a 25 year old Rwandan student, currently residing in China to complete his Master's degree in Civil Engineering. Here is his short story with Jesus.

#### Aaron's fall due to carelessness

*If you think you are standing firm, be careful that you don't fall (1 Cor 10:12)*

"I was born and raised in an evangelical Christian family and faithfully served the Lord in my local church in Rwanda. At the age of 20, I went to China to further my studies. Once in China, I did not watch over my Christian life. The lack of earnest prayer and reading of the word of God led me to temptations I could not resist. Gradually, I gave free rein to the desires of my flesh to the point of indulging in pornography, fornication, masturbation, etc. I lost almost everything: my money, I had worked for as a student, and even friends! Everything I was trying to do was not successful anymore (Ps 127:1; Jn 10:10). I was desperate, ashamed of what I had become and afraid of what my future would be. I was spiritually dead!"

#### Aaron's restoration by God's grace

*Do not boast over me, my enemy! Though I have fallen, I will rise (Micah 7:8)*

"In that messy life, a constant voice in my heart reminded me that I was sinning. By God's grace, I remembered what I had been taught since I was a little boy, that God is merciful. The Holy Spirit convinced me to repent of my sins and seek out a friend of mine, a brother in Christ who was my prayer partner, so that he could pray for me. I approached him, he prayed for me and I began a new life with Jesus. I trusted God and his forgiveness and found joy and peace in my heart. Since then I have been enjoying a deep relationship with Jesus."

#### What about you? What have you learnt?

You would also be in a messy life, struggling with sins, even on the verge of depression and suicide! Don't forget that Jesus loves you! Cry out to him and repent of your sins; trust in God's forgiveness and mercy. And if you are in a good relationship with Jesus, watch your way of life and be careful not to stray from God's grace. May His peace and grace of God be with you. Amen.

#### La chute d'Aaron due à l'imprudence

*Que celui qui croit être debout prenne garde de tomber (1 Cor 10:12)*

"Je suis né et j'ai grandi dans une famille chrétienne évangélique et j'ai fidèlement servi le Seigneur dans mon église locale au Rwanda. À l'âge de 20 ans, je suis allé en Chine pour poursuivre mes études. Une fois en Chine, je n'ai pas veillé à ma vie chrétienne. Le manque de sérieux dans la prière et la lecture de la parole de Dieu m'a conduit à des tentations auxquelles je n'ai pas pu résister. Ainsi, petit à petit, j'ai laissé libre cours aux désirs de ma chair au point de m'adonner à la pornographie, la fornication, la masturbation, etc. J'ai presque tout perdu : l'argent pour lequel j'avais travaillé en tant qu'étudiant, même les amis ! Tout ce que j'essayais de faire ne marchait plus (Ps 127:1; Jn 10:10). J'étais désespéré, j'avais honte de ce que j'étais devenu et j'avais peur de ce que serait mon avenir. J'étais spirituellement mort !"

#### La Restauration d'Aaron par la grâce de Dieu
