

Message from the Chairman

The Lord said to Gideon: '"Go in the strength you have and save Israel out of Midian's hand. Am I not sending you?" (Judges 6, 14). The members of the Groupe Biblique d'Évangélisation Sans Frontières (GBEF), spread throughout the world, particularly in Africa, North America and Europe, have decided to leave the comfort zones and take a step of faith, with the resources God has made available to us, to proclaim the Gospel of Jesus Christ. In doing so, our aim is to make disciples of Jesus Christ of all nations, races and tribes of the world and to teach them to observe all that the Lord Jesus commanded (Matthew 28:19-20).



GBEF was founded on 24 July 2021. Throughout 2021 and 2022, we focused our activities on the administrative procedures required to set up the international missionary organisation, taking into account the legal requirements in Belgium, where the organisation's registered office is located. These two years were also marked by the gathering and spiritual strengthening of members through prayer meetings and the sharing of the Word of God online (on zoom), as well as social actions in favour of members in need.

During 2023, we not only organised online evangelistic meetings, but also took the first step towards physical evangelistic missions on the ground.

During the year under review, we carried out evangelistic missions in various countries in Africa and North America. The first international evangelistic mission was to Eldoret in Kenya. This mission lasted 5 days and was organised in partnership with Christian Outreach Ministry Worldwide, Pioneer Faith Church. Our missionary team (11 missionaries) spent 5 days in this East African town and organised seminars for couples and young people, as well as outdoor evangelistic crusades in the same town. Evangelistic visits were also carried out by our teams working in the Rwanda and North America zones. In addition, we cannot list all the activities performed at individual level by GBEF members following the exhortations, encouragement and facilities provided by the organization. During our weekly prayer meetings and online sharing of God's word on zoom , we continue to receive testimonies from brothers and sisters on how the Holy Spirit is using them to bring souls to Christ.

We are firmly convinced that the Holy Spirit makes the seed we continually plant grow and flourish. God relentlessly pursues and seeks to save people from every tribe, language, people and nation. We pray that you will be encouraged as you read this report on the year 2023! We consider you a true partner and collaborator with GBEF in this noble mission to proclaim the Gospel of Jesus Christ to the ends of the earth and without borders. Thank you for joining us in this work to advance the Kingdom of God!

ONLINE REUNIFICATION

In September 2017, some of the brothers came up with the idea of creating a WhatsApp group to reconnect and communicate with each other, especially as social media had become commonplace. Those who were able to join the WhatsApp group celebrated their reunion and discovered the joy of reconnecting after a 23-year period of separation. Since then, membership of the group has continued to grow. In September 2020, a new initiative was launched: holding online meetings via the Zoom application.



This initiative triggered another revival. The former members of the GBU from 1987-1994 and their companions in the ministry committed themselves to meeting every day to share the Word of God, to pray, to edify themselves through the testimony of what God had done to them, to rekindle the flame of the Spirit in those who were spiritually lethargic and to continue to seek out others who were scattered all over the world to unite in prayer in order to rekindle the spiritual awakening in them.

n accordance with its main mission, vision and purpose, the organization was named 'Groupe Biblique d'Evangélisation sans Frontières (GBEF)' in French, 'Bible Fellowship for Evangelism without Borders (BFEB)' in English and 'Umuryango ugamije Ivugabutumwa ritagira Imipaka' in Kinyarwanda. There is no doubt that GBEF is not the result of human zeal, but rather the fulfilment of God's plan for the founding members.

The Organization's constituent General Assembly was held on 24 July 2021 to adopt the Constitution and appoint the members of the various statutory bodies. The General Assembly appointed five (5) members of the Board of Directors, the Secretary General responsible for the day-to-day management of the Organization and three (3) members of the Audit and Technical Advisory Committee. The GBEF is a Christian missionary organization registered in Belgium under the number BE0787367905.

With this initiative to get together using the Zoom application, the members were reminded of God's promise. They finally realized that wherever they are today,



each one of them is already serving the Lord (some of them have founded churches, others are at work within the local churches of which they are members, while others are serving the Lord in different areas wherever God has placed them). Nevertheless, they felt the need to work in synergy to better fulfil the mission that the Lord had entrusted to them. So they decided to establish a Christian missionary organization. _____ ____

The mission of GBEF is to spread the Gospel and to make disciples of Jesus Christ of all nations, races and tribes of the world, and to teach them to observe all that the Lord Jesus commanded.

This mission is particularly directed towards regions not yet evangelised or where the active presence of Christian churches is not tangible.

GBEF's vision is to have spiritually transformed people from every nation, tribe and race who are true followers of Jesus Christ, and to bring about a worldwide spiritual awakening to prepare the Church for the return of Jesus Christ.

Encourage members and support them in preaching the Word of God wherever they are in the world.


Proclaim the Gospel throughout the world by sending missionaries.

I. EVANGELISTIC TRIPS A. MISSION TRIPS TO AFRICA

1. Evangelism in Kenya

In 2023, a team of 11 GBEF missionaries spent seven days in the town of Eldoret (22-28 November 2023). In partnership with Christian Outreach Ministries Wordwid Church, Pioneer Faith, the following activities were carried out:

- The missionaries took part in person-to-person evangelism in the streets of Eldoret and distributed the GBEF bulletin 'The Last Call'.
- A good number of people gave their lives to Christ, according to reports from the teams who took part in this activity. Contact forms for new converts were filled in.

2. Evangelism in Rwanda

 In February 2023, the brothers and sisters of the Africa/Rwanda zone visited and shared the Word of God at the Church of Pentecost in Rwanda, Kamashashi Chapel, Kanombe, Kigali (Rwanda).

C. Evangelism trips in Europe


• In November 2023, some members of the Europe zone shared the Word of God with the congregation of the Source de Vie church in Brussels (Belgium).




While we pray for all missionaries deployed in the missions, in 2023 we also financially supported our brother Noblesse Ruhumuriza to return to South Sudan for his mission after a holiday in his native country, Rwanda. We are aware that this young missionary is carrying out God's work in difficult conditions.

We continue to pray for all missionaries on the ground.

III. ONLINE EVANGELIZATION MEETINGS

- Every Monday, we organise evangelistic meetings via a zoom application, open to anyone who understands the Kinyarwanda language (from 7.30pm to 2.30pm, Kigali time).
- Once a month, a weekend (Saturday) is consecrated to an international online evangelistic crusade.
- Twice a year, during the school holidays, we organize international conferences for young people.
- In North America, prayer meetings are organized once a month in Kinyarwanda.



IV. GETTING YOUNG PEOPLE INVOLVED

- We organize online conferences (on zoom) bringing together young people to evangelize, encourage and equip them spiritually so that they can contribute to the evangelization of their peers and even the adults around them.
- We have also set up a WhatsApp group to facilitate communication and organization.
